If there are more out-of-zone applications than spaces, a ballot will be held on 25 October 2024.

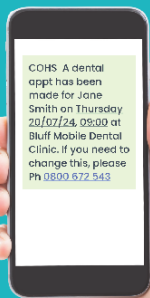
